[The Exchange Family Center](#) (EFC) makes children's lives better by strengthening their families, teachers, and communities through proven counseling, coaching, and training. EFC helps caring adults to be their best for the children in their lives. Using evidence-based programs to help change the caregiver-child dynamic and reduce children's challenging behavior, EFC has prevented trauma and strengthened families throughout our community for more than 25 years.

EFC serves more than 250 families and almost 2,000 individuals annually (2019). Yet, its services are constantly in demand--today, more than 100 families are on EFC's waitlist.

Support Cost: Foursomes are \$600; Individual Golfers are \$150.

What's Included: Your registration includes breakfast, lunch, a beer cart with free beverages, and a great round of competitive Captain's Choice tournament golf. Each sign-up includes one mulligan per player and one toss per foursome. Additional mulligan packs and tosses are available.

Each player also gets a door prize and every foursome receives 12 raffle tickets. Every year amazing raffle prizes, from sports memorabilia, to vacation related items and hotel stays, to restaurant gift certificates and more are donated to support EFC and the local families it serves. We will also have a fabulous Silent Auction on site. We get these things donated so your support goes directly to those Durham families who need EFC's help.

Golf Details: Each player plays from the tee, the team selects the best drive, and each player hits from that spot. This process is continued until the ball is holed out. Each player may lift, clean and place your ball within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer to the hole. Mulligan's and tosses may not be used from the green or the fringe of the green.

Players should play from the white tees. Ladies, juniors, or seniors are welcome to use the relevant red, light blue, or yellow tees.

There will also be a Closest to the Pin and a Longest Drive Contest.
